Keeping Texas Plains Federal strong and growing is the primary focus of your Board of Directors and the management team. We are pleased to report that 2017 was another year of solid growth and financial performance for Texas Plains Federal.

During the year, assets grew approximately \$1,646,348, ending the year at \$34,689,041 million. Net income for the year was \$176,374. Our net worth ratio continued to be strong, ending the year at 14.27%, well above the regulatory threshold.

Our active and participating members continued to be our most valuable source of growth, as they referred their family, friends and co-workers to the Credit Union. In addition to continuing to refer new business, we also ask that you keep us in mind when you are looking for your next loan. We offer competitive loan products for all of your financial needs. We look forward to serving you.

At the end of 2017, our new building in Crosbyton was completed. We are thrilled with the final product and the extra space and convenience it gives our membership in that community. This new location now has a drive up facility, which is a much needed service for this branch. If you have not been by to see our new location, we invite you to stop by.

Our Board of Directors and management team continue to look for ways to improve services to our loyal members. We are excited to announce we are now offering KASASA accounts beginning in 2018. These are free accounts that reward members for meeting monthly qualifications such as using their debit card, signing up for e-statements, and logging into online banking. We would be pleased if you ask us how you can take advantage of these rewards or you can read more about this product on our website. In addition to our KASASA accounts, we have made significant changes to our overdraft program in 2018. One of the biggest changes is that members may now access their overdraft protection for everyday purchases using their debit cards. Members can choose to add extended coverage to their Share Draft account by calling, emailing, or mailing their decision to any branch location.
