Starting in 2018 get a free Kasasa checking account at Texas Plains Federal. Kasasa is rewards based checking that let's you choose the right fit for you and your family. By meeting a few qualifications such as using e-statements, online banking, and swiping your debit card (things you are probably already doing), you can earn these rewards:

- **Kasasa Cash:** 2.00% APY on all balances up to and including \$10,000
- **Kasasa Cash Back:** 2.00% Cash back on debit card purchases up to \$375 total
- **ATM Refunds:** Up to \$25 in ATM withdrawal fee refunds (max \$4.99/transaction)
- **NO PENALTIES:** If you don't meet the monthly qualifications, there are no penalties - just try again next month. Stay tuned for more information!

Direct Deposit of IRS Refunds

Direct Deposit is a safe, reliable, and convenient way to receive Federal payments. The Department of the Treasury's Bureau of the Fiscal Service and the Internal Revenue Service both encourage direct deposit of IRS tax refunds. Direct Deposit combined with IRS e-file provides taxpayers with the fastest and safest way to receive refunds.

You can direct your refund to any of your checking or savings accounts, **but you cannot direct your refund to someone else's account, except for your spouse's account, if this is a joint refund.** No more than three electronic refunds can be directly deposited into a single financial account or pre-paid debit card. Taxpayers who exceed the limit will receive an IRS notice and a paper refund.

Upon awareness of a Tax Refund deposit to an account that the recipient of the deposit does not have direct access to, we may return that deposit to the IRS without notification.
